# Single Stream Recycling & Automated Trash Collection



This flyer explains an exciting new program to begin Monday, November, 16<sup>th</sup>, Single Stream Recycling and Automated Trash Collection. Single Stream Recycling allows residents to combine ALL recyclables (paper and cardboard, bottles and cans) together in one 96 gallon recycling container. Updates on this program will be posted to the Town's website ([www.dedham-ma.gov/recycling](http://www.dedham-ma.gov/recycling))

- **Logistics:** Each household will receive one 96 gallon recycling toter and one 64 gallon trash toter free of charge. The toters will be delivered to your home between October 26<sup>th</sup> and November 13<sup>th</sup>. Please do not use these toters until the start of the program, November 16<sup>th</sup>.
- **Additional Recycling Bin Request:** You may request one additional recycling bin free of charge. Requests will be accepted after the start of the program in November. A form for making this request will be posted on the Town of Dedham's website and available in the Town Administrator's office after November 16<sup>th</sup>.
- **Additional Trash Bin Request:** Seniors and those living alone may request a 32 gallon trash toter (instead of a 64 gallon trash toter) free of charge. Requests for smaller bins can be made by contacting the Town Administrator's Office, DPW or Environmental Department at the numbers listed below or by emailing [singlestream@dedham-ma.gov](mailto:singlestream@dedham-ma.gov).

Requests for a second 64 gallon trash toter will cost \$50 for the toter and \$70 per year for disposal. Households with 6 or more family members requesting a second trash toter can apply for a fee waiver. Trash Bin changes or requests will be accepted two months after the start of the program. A form for making this request will be posted on the Town of Dedham's website and available in the Town Administrator's office after November 16<sup>th</sup>.

- **Recycling Old Trash Barrels:** Residents can recycle old trash barrels and recycling bins by bringing them to the St. Mary's Parking lot on November 14<sup>th</sup>, 21<sup>st</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> between the hours of 8am and 12pm.
- **Recycling Schedule:** Recycling will remain bi-weekly, please refer to your current calendar for pick up dates.
- **Yard Waste/Bulky Items/White Goods:** Yard Waste collection will remain the same. White Goods and Bulky Items will need to be called in for pick-up by contacting Russell Disposal at 1-888-870-8882. Bulky items will be collected on Friday of each week.
- **Putting trash out:** In order for the automated arm to pick up the toters, toters must be placed a minimum of 2 feet apart with the opening to the lids facing the street.
