





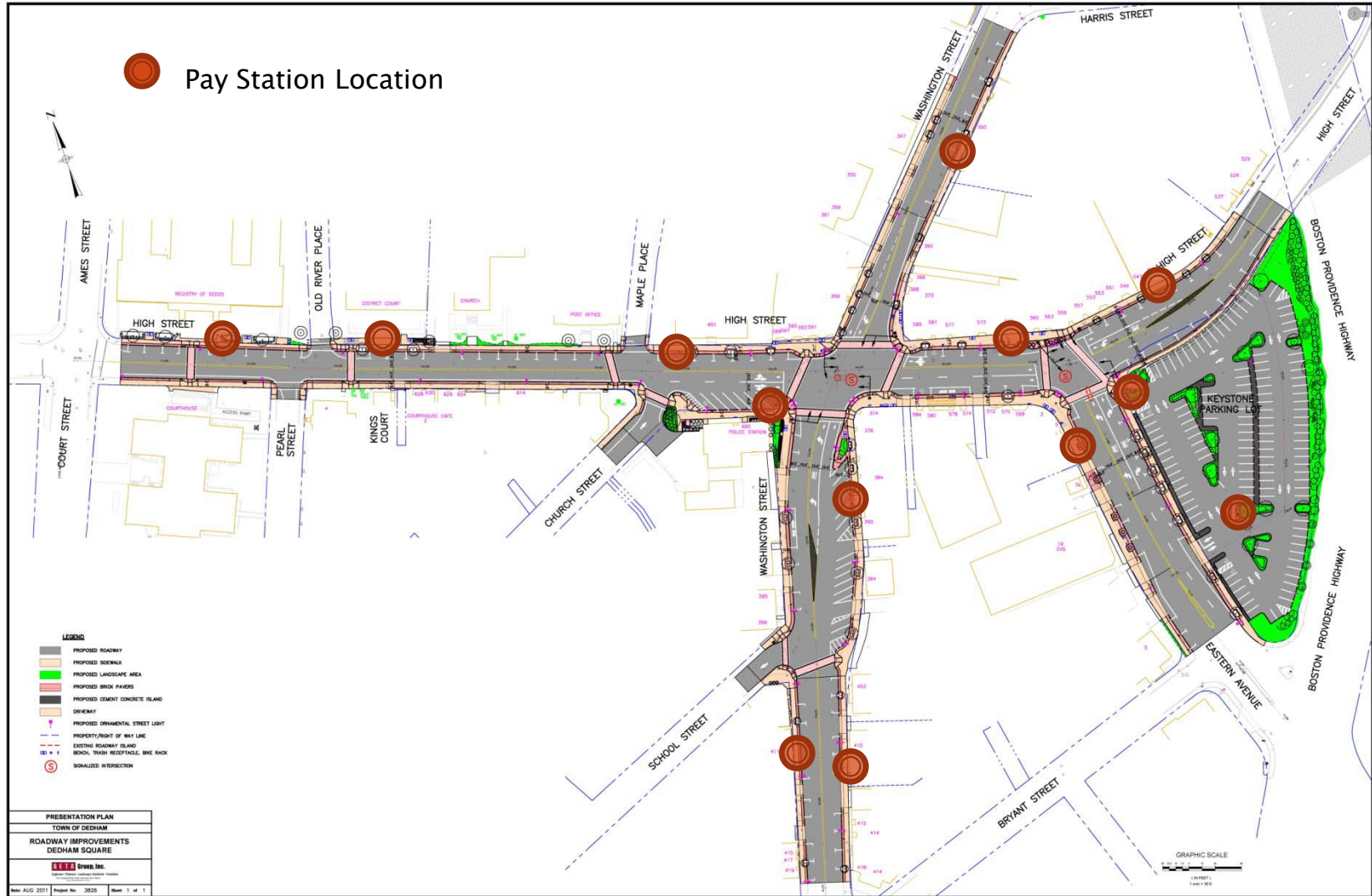
DEDHAM SQUARE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

PAY STATION PRESENTATION

HISTORY

- On May 16th, 2010, Town Meeting voted to authorize the borrowing of \$6.1 million dollars with \$4.8 million being paid locally and the remaining \$1.3 million to be paid through reimbursement from the State as part of a Public Works Economic Development (PWED) grant awarded to the Town in October of 2010.
 - In May, 2011 the State awarded the Town an additional \$400,000 to help further offset the cost of construction bringing the total project budget to \$6.5 million.
 - The construction contract was awarded to Fed Corp in February 2012 and construction started on April 6, 2012.
 - As of September 2013, the project has reached substantial completion.
 - The contractor is currently completing the project punch list and anticipates final completion in the next couple of months.
 - The project has provided an additional 24 parking spaces throughout the Square.

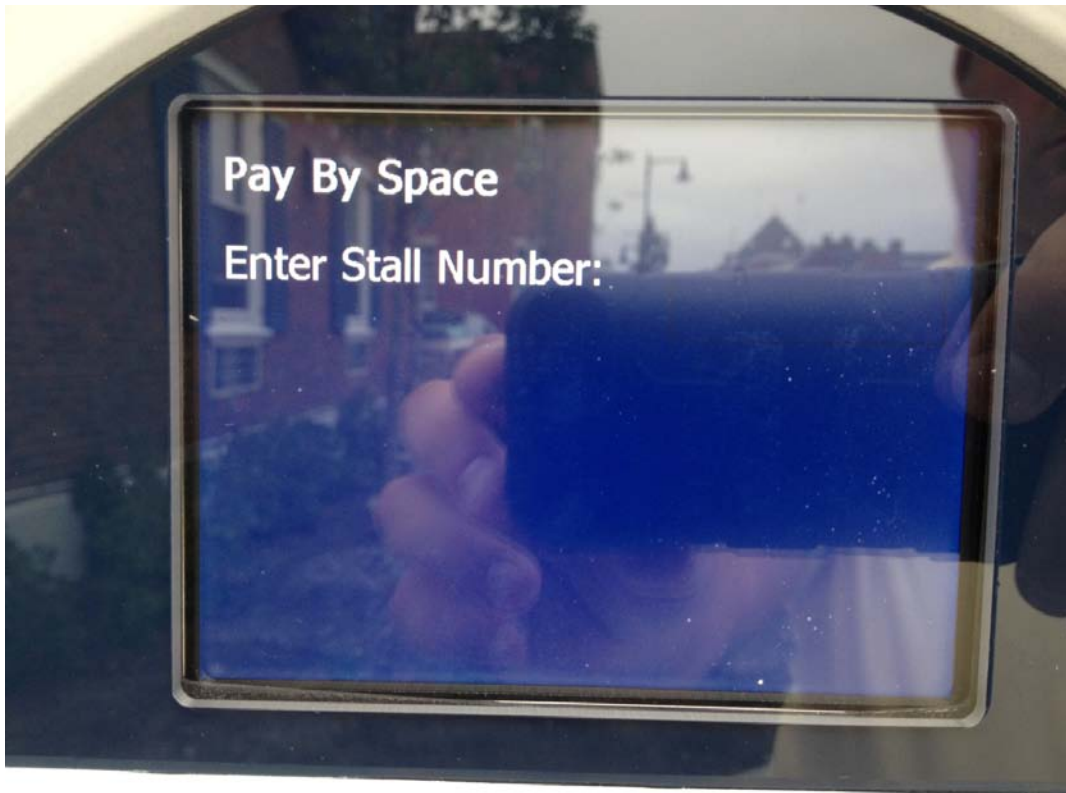

Stall (space) number etched into the granite curbing.



Stall (space) number painted at the top of the stall.

Your Stall (Space) number can be found on the top of the granite curbing for on-street parking spaces and painted on the ground at the front of the space in the Keystone Parking Lot.

For this example an on-street stall (space) number was entered.

Options:

- 1) 15 MIN FREE PARKING
- 2) 30 MINUTES / \$.25
- 3) 45 MINUTES / \$.50
- 4) 1 HR\$.75 CASH/CREDIT

1. Exact change ONLY.
2. Does NOT make change.
3. Coins & bills can be used for all options.
4. Credit Cards can only be used for 1 HR transaction.

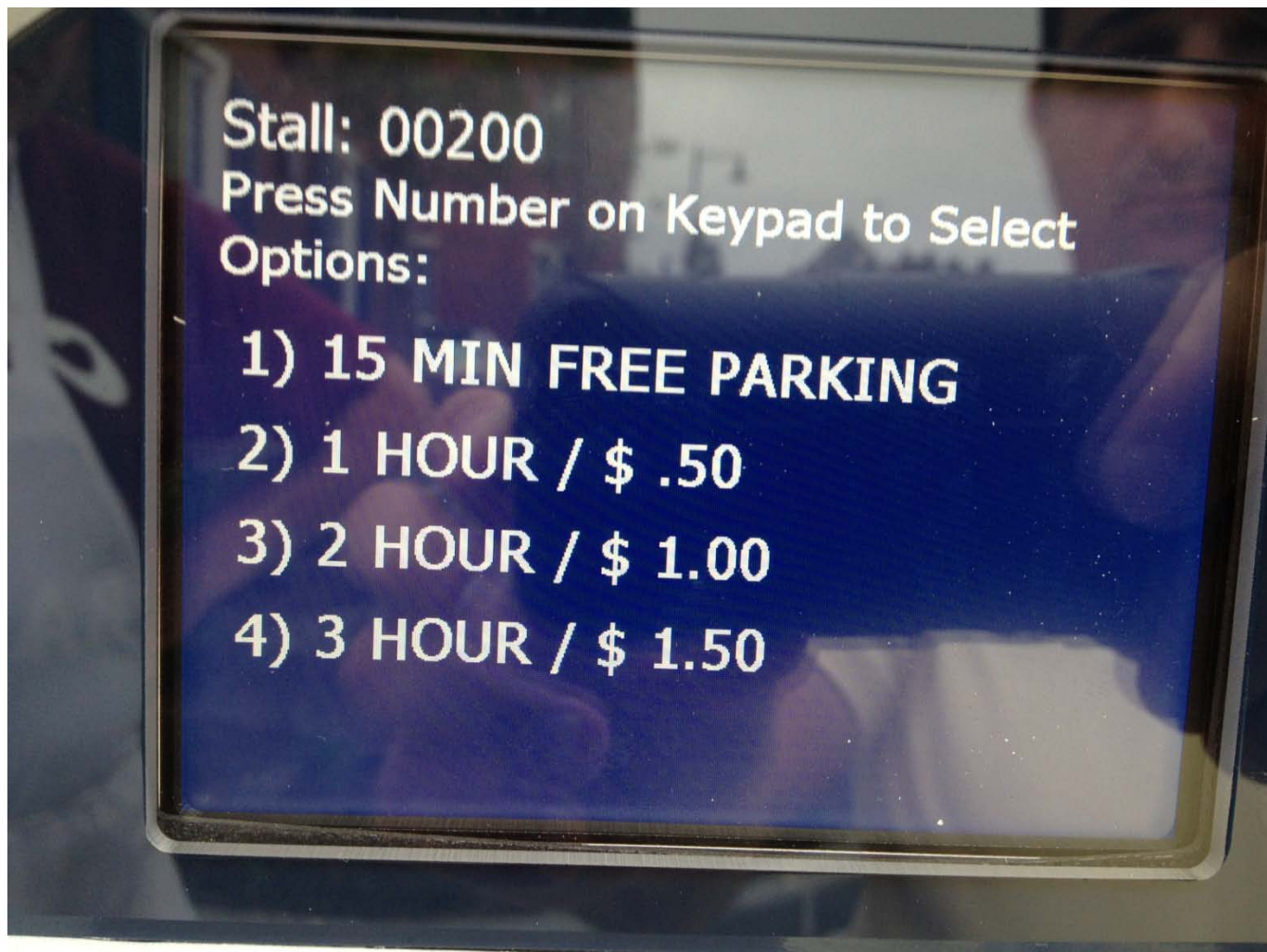

Typical Receipt

- Once your transaction is complete, then retrieve your receipt from the receipt drawer. On your receipt you will find 2 important pieces of information:

1. The stall (space) number where your vehicle is parked.
2. The expiration date & time for your parking space.

- **You do NOT have to go back to your car to display the receipt on your dashboard!!**

- Once you have completed your transaction you can go about your business. If you need to pay for additional time, you can do so at any one of the 13 pay stations so long as you remember your stall (space) number.

?? FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ??

Q: What type of credit cards will be accepted at the Pay Stations?

A: The Pay Stations will accept Mastercard, Visa & Discover.

Q: What denomination of coin will be accepted at the Pay Stations?

A: The Pay Stations will accept nickels, dimes and quarters. **NO PENNIES.**

Q: What denomination of bill will be accepted at the Pay Stations?

A: The Pay Stations will **ONLY** accept one (\$1.00) dollar bills.

Q: What should I do if my credit card gets stuck or the coin acceptor is jammed?

A: Either go to the Police Station at 600 High Street or call the Police Station at 781-326-1212 and tell them what has happened and what pay station you are currently at. An officer should be able to come and help you out.

Q: Can I prepay for my parking space if I arrive before enforcement hours begin at 8:00 AM?

A: The Pay Stations will except prepayments starting at 7:00AM. Therefore, if you are parking in the Keystone Lot, you may purchase 3 hours of parking at 7:00 AM and the 3 hours will not start until 8:00 AM.

Q: I put \$1.00 in the Pay Station to pay for an hour of on-street parking. Where is my \$0.25 change?

A: The Pay Stations **DO NOT** make change. We suggest using exact change if you plan on using coins or bills to pay for parking.

Q: I parked in the Keystone Lot and purchased 2 hours of parking at the Pay Station in the Lot and then headed to the Court House to take care of my business. After a while I realized that I had 5 minutes left on my space. Do I have to run all the way back to the Pay Station in the Keystone Lot to purchase the remaining hour?

A: No. So long as you remember the stall (space) number you parked in, then you can purchase additional time at any one of the 13 Pay Stations located conveniently throughout the Square.
