Weekly Project Updates and
7-Day Look-Ahead

**Here is a look-ahead at the construction work planned for the Public Safety Building,
from May 29, 2023 through June 2, 2023**

Project Status and Overview:

As of May 2, 2023, the Police Department, Fire Department, and Dispatch Team are operating out of the new Public Safety Building. The former Police Station, located at 600 High Street, will become the future Town Green, and the former Fire Station is currently undergoing abatement in advance of demolition. The building will be razed in Phase 3 of the Public Safety Building Project and will be replaced with parking spaces and small landscaped areas. The new combined Public Safety Building will replace two older Town buildings: Police Station at 600 High Street (built in 1962) and the Fire Station at 436 Washington Street (built in 1952). The new building is scheduled to reach final completion later this year and remains on budget.

What to expect May 29, 2023 (Monday) through June 2, 2023 (Friday):

- The new Public Safety Building is open to the public at 26 Bryant Street.
- **The site will be closed on Monday, May 29, 2023 for Memorial Day and will reopen Tuesday, May 30 at 7AM.**
- Demolition of the Fire Station Tower was completed as of Friday, May 26, 2023 and crews have been clearing the site of materials and backfilling the excavated areas.
 - Site clean-up, backfilling, and compaction will continue this week and may cause additional noise and vibrations. Please contact the Project Team at psb@dedham-ma.gov or by calling 781-751-9100 if you have any questions or concerns.
- Landscaping crews have started planting around the new Public Safety Building and along the perimeter of the rear parking lot at Town Hall. This work will continue this week and parking spaces may be blocked off for large equipment and storage. Please take extreme caution when driving through these parking areas.
- Demolition and site work at the location of the former Fire Station Building is expected to be completed in June 2023 and may result in additional noise during normal business hours, 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday.
- Upon completion of the demolition work, the site will be converted to additional parking spaces and landscaping that will connect the Town Hall and new Public Safety Building in a Municipal Campus.
- Expect periodic entrance and exit of large trucks at the project site entrance. **Please expect minor traffic delays at this intersection.**
- No additional traffic impacts or pedestrian impacts are anticipated during this week.

 - Tuesday through Friday: 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM
