Mr. Bethoney called the meeting to order at 7:05 pm and welcomed Mr. McGuinness to the TAC.

Mr. Bethoney opened **Agenda item # 1, Traffic Calming Request # 2014-001, Taylor Avenue:** Discussion with Applicant.

Mr. Brian McKenna, applicant, was in attendance. Mr. Bethoney asked Mr. Mammone to review the Traffic Evaluation, dated 11/12/2015. Mr. Mammone provided an over view of his recommendations as outlined in the Traffic Evaluation that included crash data, speed analysis and traffic counts. The findings conclude that Traffic Calming is not recommended for Taylor Avenue. Low cost measures, such as Step II Kid Alert, establishment of a neighborhood group, staggered resident parking and placement of the "your speed is" signage, through coordination with the DPD.

Chief D'Entremont will place Taylor Ave. on the list for the "your speed is" signage.

Mr. Bethoney thanked Mr. Mammone for his thorough and detailed analysis and asked Mr. McKenna if he had any questions. Mr. McKenna was satisfied with the review and recommendations and thanked the DPD for adding Taylor Avenue to the list of streets for the "your speed is" signage.

Mr. Mammone told Mr. McKenna that he could file again in a year if conditions worsened. Mr. McKenna thanked the TAC.

Mr. Bethoney sought comments from the TAC, being none, Mr. Bethoney stated that the TAC concurs with the Engineering Department's recommendations. Mr. Mammone will draft a letter to be reviewed by the TAC at the next meeting and sent to the applicant.

Mr. Bethoney called **Agenda item # 2 Traffic Calming Request #2015-01, River Street:** vote on decision.

Mr. Bethoney asked if members read the decision letter to Ms. Lustig and sought comments or questions on same. Being none, Mr. Guilfoyle made a motion to approve the letter as drafted, 2<sup>nd</sup> James Antonizick, UA.

Mr. Bethoney called **Agenda item # 3 Approval of Minutes from 11/17/2015**

Mr. Bethoney sought comments on the minutes, being none, Mr. Guilfoyle made a motion to approve minutes as drafted, 2<sup>nd</sup> James Antonizick, all in favor, Mr. McGuinness abstain.(was absent for the 11/17/2015 meeting)

Mr. Mammone stated they were caught up on all Traffic Calming Requests. He mentioned that the section of Madison Street from Cedar to MT. Vernon was not included in the previous traffic calming study. It is possible that a request may be filed by those residents.

Mr. Bethoney reminded and suggested all TAC members drive the streets that are being reviewed under traffic calming.

Mr. Mammone stated the TAC would meet next on 1/19/16.
